Dear Parent / Carer

We hope that your child is enjoying their final term at primary school, but also looking forward to the move to Up Holland High in September. We wanted to give you some more information about key events that are coming up:

On Wednesday 29th June we will be holding our Transition Day for all Y6 students. This will give them the opportunity to experience a typical day at Up Holland High School, as well as meeting key members of staff, including their Personal Development Tutor. They should come to Up Holland in their current school uniform, including school shoes and arrive at school by 8.45am, gathering by the turning circle; **you will need to organise their transport arrangements for this day.** The students will experience maths, English and science lessons, as well as having opportunities to find out more about the other subjects we deliver at KS3. There will be a morning break of 30 minutes where toast will be provided and a lunch break lasting 45 minutes; they can either bring a packed lunch or choose a school dinner, which will be free to all students. The school day will end at 2.50pm and you should make arrangements for your child.


